- A. Admonition that results in proper repentance (7:2-11)
 - 1. Paul's comfort and joy from Titus' arrival and report (v. 2-7)
 - 2. Message of genuine repentance (v.8-11).
- B. Corinthians' obedience establishes confidence and deepens affections (7:12-16)
