- I. BEGINNING OF JESUS' GREAT GALILEAN MINISTRY (4:14-5:16)
 - A. Jesus returns in the power of the Spirit to Galilee fame increases throughout the region (v. 14-15).
 - B. Jesus rejected in Nazareth (v. 16-30).
 - 1. Jesus reads Isaiah 61:1-2 causes wonderment.
 - 2. Jesus applies it to Himself causes doubt and rejection.

 - F. Jesus with the miraculous catch of fish calls fishing disciples to be fishers of men (5:1-11).
 - 1. Peter amazed at the catch of fish.
 - 2. Jesus declares, "from henceforth thou shalt catch men."
 - G. Jesus heals a pleading leper (5:12-16).
 - 1. Man "full" of leprosy.
 - 2. Jesus heals him with the touch of his hand.
 - 3. Great multitudes come to hear and be healed.
 - 4. Jesus withdrew to desert places to pray.
