

## LUKE – LESSON 9

### I. JESUS CONTINUES HIS TEACHING AND HEALING IN GALILEE (8:1-56)

- A. Jesus teaches good tidings of the kingdom of God with the twelve in the cities and villages – the ministering women (v. 1-3).
- B. Jesus teaches by the parable of the sower (v. 4-15).
  - 1. Jesus reveals the purpose of the parables (v. 9-10)
  - 2. Jesus explains the meaning of the parable of the sower (v. 11-15)
- C. Jesus uses lighted lamp illustration to convey some characteristics of revelation – warning to take heed how one hears (v. 16-18).
- D. Jesus' mother and brothers provide opportunity for Jesus to teach of the character of his spiritual family – hear the word of God and do it (v. 19-21).
- E. Jesus rebukes the wind and waves in the lake of Galilee (v. 22-25).
- F. Jesus heals the Gerasenes' man of a legion of demons (v. 26-39)
- G. Jesus raises Jairus' only daughter from the dead after healing the woman who touches Jesus' garment (v.40-56).
