How Do We Come Back?

Is. 59:1-2

Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. But your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.

- If disobedience is the thing that separates us from God and condemns us, how do we come back to Him?

REVERSE THE PROCESS!!!

Reverse The Process

Acts 2:36-38

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?"

Rom. 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Look at this from the negative side:

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Not Good Enough To Be:

In A Way

Prov. 16:25

There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.

Jer. 10:23

O LORD, I know the way of man is not in himself; it is not in man who walks to direct his own steps.

Mat. 7:13-14

"Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

Not Good Enough To Be:

In A Way

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

➤ Is it Good Enough to be “Religious”?

Not Good Enough To Be:

Religious

Gal. 1:13-14

For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it. And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers.

Acts 8:26-39

Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza."

This is desert. So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet.

Not Good Enough To Be:

Religious

Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot." So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?" And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him. The place in the Scripture which he read was this: "He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; And as a lamb before its shearer is silent, So He opened not His mouth. In His humiliation His justice was taken away, And who will declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth." So the eunuch answered Philip and said, "I ask you, of whom does the prophet say this, of himself or of some other man?" Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him. Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

Not Good Enough To Be:

Honest

Acts 23:1

Then Paul, looking earnestly at the council, said, "Men and brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day."

The conscience only reacts to what you have been taught

Acts 22:10, 16

So I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?' And the Lord said to me, 'Arise and go into Damascus, and there you will be told all things which are appointed for you to do.'

16 And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

Not Good Enough To Be:

Morally Good

Acts 10:1-6, 48

There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian Regiment, a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and prayed to God always. About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius!" And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God. Now send men to Joppa, and send for Simon whose surname is Peter. He is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea. He will tell you what you must do."

48 And he [Peter] commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

Not Good Enough To Be:

Morally Good

- Later Peter had to give an account about WHY he taught this gentile the Gospel

Acts 11:14

The Spirit told Cornelius that Peter, "...will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved."

What about being a believer? Is that Good Enough?

Millions believe you are saved when you become a believer

Not Good Enough To Be:

A Believer

James 2:19-26

You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe--and tremble! But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect? And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God. You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only. Likewise, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Not Good Enough To Be:

A Believer

James 2:14-18

What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

- ✓ Recall the Faith Hall of Fame from Heb. 11 - "By faith. . ."

Not Good Enough To Be:

A Believer

Heb. 3:15-19

“...while it is said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion." For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief

Not Good Enough To Be:

A Believer

John 3:36

He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

James 2:20-23

But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? 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Not Good Enough To Be:

Almost Persuaded

Acts 26:27-28

King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you do believe.“
Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You almost persuade me to become a
Christian." And Paul said, "I would to God that not only you, but also all
who hear me today, might become both almost and altogether such as I
am, except for these chains."

Not Good Enough To Be:

- It is not good enough to be:
 - ✓ IN A WAY
 - ✓ RELIGIOUS
 - ✓ HONEST
 - ✓ MORALLY PURE
 - ✓ A BELIEVER
 - ✓ ALMOST PERSUADED

- In fact it is not good enough if you had all of those traits

Mat. 28:19

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,...

But when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

How?

Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Acts 2:41-3:1

Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Hear Him

Redeemed

Acts 20:28

Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.



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
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Importance of Being “In Christ”

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Steps Toward Salvation

Heb. 5:7-9

Steps Toward Salvation

➤ *Notice*

- ✓ Believing, Repenting & Confessing get you moving toward salvation
- ✓ BAPTISM puts you INTO CHRIST
 - ❖ ***THAT IS WHERE THE SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS ARE***

If you stop one step short you are not IN CHRIST

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
