## THE CHURCH – LESSON 1

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The church was instituted in time (A.D. 30-33) but inseparable from God's eternal purpose for man (Acts 2:47 (KJV), Ephesians 3:8-12)
  - a. Eternal purpose of salvation in Christ (v.11, Eph. 1:4, Isa. 2:3, Acts 2:5, 2:47)
  - b. Eternal purpose of God's wisdom of salvation for man on earth, made known to angels in heaven (v.10, I Cor. 1:23-25, 30).
  - c. Eternal purpose made known through the preaching of Christ (v. 8-9, Acts 26:18-19)
- 2. In this first lesson we will establish in our minds the definition of the word "church," the focus of our study.
  - a. We seek to also see how the word church is used in our New Testaments.
  - b. We seek to understand the church in the context of religious unity.

#### I. "CHURCH" DEFINED:

- A. "Old English *cir(i)ce*, *cyr(i)ce*, related to Dutch *kerk* and German *Kirche*, based on medieval Greek *kurikon*, from Greek *kuriakon* (*dōma*) 'Lord's (house)', from *kurios* 'master or lord'. "
  - 1. Not the Greek word translated "church" in the New Testament"
- B. The Greek word ("Ekklesia" "ek"- out + "Kaleo" to call)
  - 1. Translated "assembly" denoting a tumultuous confused gathering (Acts 19:32,41); A legal secular governmental gathering (Acts 19:39)
  - 2. Translated "congregation" "church" (KJV) "assembly" (NIV) denoting the "called-out people of Israel" who wondered in the wilderness (Acts 7:38)
  - 3. Denotes the saints in Christ "called out of the world of sin" (I Pet. 2:9)
    - a. Those who comprise the body of the saved (Eph. 5:23)
    - b. Jesus promised to build this collection of people (Matt. 16:18)
    - c. Saul made havoc of this collectivity of people through persecution (Acts 8:3)
    - d. Comprised of saints (I Cor. 1:1-2).
- II. CHURCH IN ITS "UNIVERSAL" AND "LOCAL" SENSE: (Adapted from an article by Robert F. Turner Collection of Plain talk articles: Plain Talk About God's Church, p. 9-10)
  - A. Universal- relationship of individuals with God
    - 1. Entered by baptism (I Cor. 12:13)
    - 2. Lord "add" members (Acts 2:47)
    - 3. All saints are located here (Gal. 3:27)
    - 4. Assembled figuratively (Heb. 12:23)
    - 5. Satan cannot prevail against it (Matt. 16:18)

- B. Local relationship of individuals with Saints
  - 1. "join" ourselves to (Acts 9:26)
  - 2. By agreement with fellow saints (3 Jn. 10)
  - 3. Certain saints are located here (I Cor. 1:2)
  - 4. Assembled literally (I Cor. 14:23)
  - 5. Satan can and does prevail (Rev. 2:5)

## III. THE UNIQUNESS OF THE CHURCH

- A. One Body:
  - 1. "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye were called in in one hope of your calling; one Lord one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all, and through all, and in all" (Ephesians 4:4-6).
- B. One Head:
  - 1. "...and He put all things in subjection under His feet and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fulness of Him that filleth all in all (Ephesians 1:22-23).
- C. The foundation for UNITY
  - 1. One body comprised by members who have been called through the revelation and confirming power of the One Spirit of God unto one hope of eternal inheritance in heaven
  - 2. One body with all its members having become members through one faith and one baptism unto one Lord, Jesus Christ.
  - One body with all its members being filled by one God who fills all in all.
