5. Read Joshua 2 and answer the following questions:
 - a. How many spies did Joshua send in to Jericho before it was conquered?
 - b. Who commanded Rahab to bring the spies to him after it was found out that they had entered the city?
 - c. How did Rahab describe the feelings of the people of Jericho after they had heard about the success of Israel crossing the Red Sea and defeating the Amorites?
 - d. What did Rahab request in exchange for helping the spies hide?
 - e. What visible object was to be displayed in Rahab's window so that Israel would know which home belonged to her when they attacked?
 - f. Where did the spies hide after they left Rahab's house?
