Outline of the book:

1. Greek meaning of the word “Deuteronomy” – Second Law
2. Location of the book: Read Dt. 1:1
3. In class we will review the timeline between Genesis and Deuteronomy:
 - a. Genesis: From the Creation to Joseph
 - b. Exodus: Israel leaves Egypt and goes to Mount Sinai
 - c. Leviticus: Giving of the law of Moses at Sinai
 - d. Numbers: 40 years of wandering in the wilderness
 - e. Deuteronomy: Farewell addresses from Moses and Death of Moses
4. Book is divided into 3 Sermons:
 - a. Sermon 1 (Dt. 1:1 – 4:43) Moses retells Israel’s history in the wilderness
 - b. Sermon 2 (Dt. 4:44 – 26:19) Moses reviews the Law
 - c. Sermon 3 (Dt. 27:1 – 31:30) Warnings regarding following God’s Law

2. What is he doing when he died?
3. Did God allow Moses to go into the land of Canaan?
4. How old was Moses when he died?
