

FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT : SELF-CONTROL

LESSON 9

I. SELF-CONTROL DEFINED:

- A. The Greek word , EGKRATEIA, is translated "TEMPERANCE" (KJV) and "SELF-CONTROL" (ASV, NAS, NIV, NKJ).**
- B. The word conveys strength as one "takes hold of" or has a "grip" on self.**
- C. In the LXX, the word is used to describe one who is in control of self, especially his emotions:**
 - 1. Joseph refraining from further tears (Gen. 43:30-31).
 - 2. Haman refraining from outward burst of anger (Esther 5:9-10).
- D. "Master of self" - Thayer describes this word as "the virtue of one who masters his desires and passions, especially his sensual appetites" (Thayer's Greek-English Lexicon, pp. 166-167).**
 - 1. Lacking in the life of Felix (Acts 24:24-26)

II. SELF-CONTROL IS NECESSARY IN THE LIFE OF THE CHRISTIAN

- A. A necessary element in pure and undefiled religion (James 1:26-27).**
- B. That which we "bring in beside" of God's redeeming and purifying work (Gal. 5:23, 2 Pet. 1:4-6).**
- C. In control of our body, not our desires in control of us (I Cor.9:25)**
 - 1. In control of even "natural" desires to the glory of God (I Cor. 10:31, cf. I Cor. 7:9).
- D. Must be seen in the lives of our spiritual leaders - elders (Titus 1:8).**
