I. JESUS' MIRACULOUS WORK AND TEACHING AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE AND IN HIS LATER PEREAN MINISTRY (9:2-10:52).

- A. Jesus TRANSFIGURED before Peter, James and John in a high mountain - Follow-up discussion concerning Jesus' resurrection and the coming of Elijah (9:2-13).
- B. Jesus finds disciples being questioned by the Scribes over their inability to cast out a demon from a young boy - Jesus casts it out (9:14-29).
 - 1. Jesus in private tells his disciples that "this kind" comes out only by "prayer".
- C. Jesus desires to pass through Galilee secretly with his disciples - He predicts his death and resurrection (9:30-32).
- D. In Capernaum Jesus responds to the disciples discussing greatness by emphasizing service and humility (9:33-37).
- E. Jesus rebukes John who forbids one who was not among the apostles from casting out demons in Jesus' name (9:38-41).
- F. Jesus speaks of the horrors of Hell for those who cause Jesus' believers to stumble (9:42-50). - - - *a period of about SIX MONTHS passes before MK.10* - - -
- G. Beyond the Jordan, probably in the region of Perea, Jesus answers Pharisees' questions concerning divorce (10:1-12).
- H. Jesus blesses little children and teaches disciples about entering the Kingdom of God (10:13-16).
- I. Jesus teaches an inquiring rich man about the conditions for him to receive eternal life (10:17-22).
- J. Jesus teaches disciples about trusting in riches-and tells them of the rewards of following Him (10:23-31).
- K. Heading toward Jerusalem, Jesus predicts specifically of actions leading up to His death and the fact of His resurrection (10:32-34).
- L. Jesus rebukes James' and John's request to sit on his right and left hand in glory (10:32-45).
- M. Jesus miraculously heals Bartimaeus of blindness at Jericho (10:46-52).
