II. PAUL WARNS TIMOTHY AGAINST VAIN DISPUTES (2:14-26)

- A. As a “workman,” shun profane babblings (v. 14-19)
 - 1. Example of false doctrine concerning the resurrection.

- B. As an “honored vessel,” flee youthful lusts (v. 20-23)
 - 1. Follow:
 - a. Righteousness
 - b. Faith
 - c. Love
 - d. Peace

 - 2. Refuse foolish and ignorant questionings.

- C. As the “Lord’s servant,” do not strive (v. 24-26).
 - 1. Be gentle.
 - 2. Be apt to teach.
 - 3. Be forbearing.
 - 4. Correct in meekness.
